Halloween Balloon Game

Blow up orange balloons and stick them to a wall with tape or pins. Shape the balloons into a large pumpkin. You could also spell out "Halloween" with the black balloons. Place prizes inside the balloons such as candy, cute notes but not any kind of sharp objects. You can use a funnel to insert prizes into the balloons. With black balloons, no one can see the prizes. With orange balloons, this will allow players to view the contents, if not clearly. After the balloons are arranged on a wall, just call the name of a player and let that person pop a specified number of balloons. Let every player win something or call fewer names than there are balloons for more suspense and laughable disappointment.

Halloween Shapes Guess Game

Cut out lots and lots of pumpkin shapes, bats, or other Halloween-theme images, and use them as a game of guessing. Be sure to count how many you've cut out. Staple or tape the chosen shapes on a wall or board and make sure to put many of them up – in all different sizes and/or colors. All one color will make it more difficult. Players must guess how many there are. The person who guesses the closest wins, and in the case of a tie, they split the prize, or you can have a secondary prize.

Halloween Candy in a Jar Guess Game

Dump some wrapped Halloween candies into a jar and play another guessing game. Count how many pieces of candy there are in the jar. Let the players look at the jar, and the person who guesses closest, wins the jar of candy.

Halloween Hiding Game

Hide paper jack-o-lanterns, bats or other images around the office or workplace. You can write the name of a prize on each one or you can just play for a prize to the player who gathers the most paper images. You can give the players a certain amount of time to hunt for the images or you can let them have all day to “accidentally” find some of them.

Halloween Word Game

Give workers a single word, like “Halloween”, and see how many words they can make from it. You can print out a guide online, where you can find a website that shows you all the words which can be made from most any single word. Give everyone a certain amount of time to make the list then see who wins.

Halloween Spookiest Office Game

Have each employee help decorate their office as a group and the spookiest office set-up wins. You can also compete to have the best costume.

Halloween Mummy Wrap Game

This is a hilarious game and brilliant for getting into the mood for Halloween. Wrap your coworker or friend in toilet paper to turn them into a creep scary mummy and then turn and run away from them when the “mummy” tries to chase you.

Halloween Apple Bobbing Game

Bobbing for apples is a traditional game that many of your employees might decide to skip but it is fun for those who are interested. It’s a laughter generator for those who are not participating. Just get a number two wash tub or something to hold water and put approximately 10 apples in the tub of water and see which employee can get the most apples out of the tub in the least amount of time.
